- aim to meet or exceed legislation requirements through best practice environmental management;

- implement actions to mitigate and offset impacts to biodiversity;

- ensure providers of services and materials share the responsibility of meeting Sheffield's environmental standards;
- regularly review environmental performance objectives and targets and continually seek opportunities for improvement; and
- publicly report on environmental performance.
